

Protected Areas Management Policy

1. Purpose

This policy outlines SRF Altech Ltd.'s commitment to identifying and managing Protected Areas within its Area of Influence to ensure that operations do not adversely impact the integrity and values of these areas.

2. Scope

This policy applies to all facilities and operations of SRF Altech Ltd., including both existing and new operations.

3. Core Principles

Identification: Identify Protected Areas within the Area of Influence.

Compliance: Adhere to regulations, covenants, and legal requirements related to Protected Areas.

Management Plans: Develop and implement management plans to protect the special values of Protected Areas.

Transparency: Publicly disclose management plans in an accessible manner.

4. Policy Guidelines

4.1 Identification of Protected Areas

Area of Influence: Identify all Protected Areas within the Area of Influence using resources such as:

Integrated Biodiversity Assessment Tool (IBAT): Includes directories of Protected Areas globally.

World Database on Protected Areas (WDPA): Provides access based on IUCN Management Categories, Governance, and Designation.

Other Sources: Consider local and national databases for the most accurate and updated information.

4.2 Compliance

Regulations and Legal Requirements:

Adherence: Comply with all applicable regulations, covenants, and legal requirements related to Protected Areas within the Area of Influence.

4.3 Management Plans

Development and Collaboration:

Management Plans: Develop management plans in collaboration with relevant Protected Area management authorities and, where possible, with the participation of Affected Populations and Organisations.

Integration: Integrate management plans with other relevant management systems and risk-based approaches.

Implementation: Ensure that the Entity's activities and Facilities do not adversely impact the special values for which the Protected Areas are designated.

4.4 Disclosure

Transparency:

Public Disclosure: Publicly disclose management plans in a manner that is accessible and understandable to Affected Populations and Organisations.

5. Documentation and Integration

5.1 Policy Documentation

Internal Documentation: Maintain internal documentation that details the identification, compliance, and management of Protected Areas.

Management Plans: Document and integrate management plans into the Entity's overall management systems.

5.2 Integration

Policy Integration: Ensure this policy is integrated with other environmental and social management systems to ensure comprehensive protection of Protected Areas.

6. Application

6.1 Facilities

Applicability: This policy applies to all facilities and operations of SRF Altech Ltd.

6.2 Not Applicable

Exemptions: This policy is not applicable if no Protected Areas are identified in the Area of Influence.


7. Review and Continuous Improvement
